Terms of Reference for Hāto Petera Te Waka o Hāto Petera Wāwāhi Ara to operate working with the Bishop and Kāhui Kaumātua in a spirit of co-operation and trust to deliver the mahi over the next six years.

VISION

Provide education for all, using a Māori Katorika framework

RELATIONSHIP

Strengthen relationship between Māori & Catholic Church

An **apostolate** of the Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Auckland ("Bishop")

EMPOWER

Group to develop vision and plan

Establish a Te Waka o Hāto Petera Wāwāhi Ara

The Wāwāhi Ara shall consist of not less than five (5) and not more than (9) members recognised for their skills in governance, strategy, financial planning, and management. Membership will reflect the **Māori Katorika nature of the kaupapa**. Selection of members will be via an expression of interest process managed by the Te Pou Arahi (Vicar for Māori).

TODAY

AUGUST
